The following is an example of his descriptions: The third vertebra has eminences by which it is connected with the next inferior one. All the others are articulated with those below by processes inclining downwards, and by corresponding depressions which they have on each side they receive the superior ones, and are secured by many ligaments on each side, and an abundance of inter-articular cartilage. And thus a moderate degree of flexion is readily given to a man as he stands erect, and is as readily counteracted...
